Drop-in sessions and presentation

Thanks to everyone who attended last week's drop-in sessions and Friday's presentation about the possible repurposing of the school. The slides from the presentation and financial projections are now available on the TKCC website via this link

As discussed at the meeting there is still a lot of work to be done as we work towards acquiring the school buildings from Highland Council as a Community Asset Transfer. We will proceed with caution and be mindful of 'red flags' which may delay or stop the process entirely.

The indications are that acquiring the former playpark site will be less costly, however we still must be sure to complete all due diligence checks as we go through this process.

Highland Council have indicated that they may move to put the school and playpark site on the market for private sale before the end of the year but, as TDCA has put in a formal Expression of Interest, the community will have first refusal.

We will keep you updated.
